**ZipForm Renewal**

Have you opened your ZipForm 6 or Plus account lately? You may receive a notification to renew your subscription. The renewal is required in order to validate your Association membership. The renewal process is simple.

New this year, the National Association of REALTORS® and zipLogix have entered into a partnership to provide zipForm Plus and zipTMS as a member benefit at no cost to all NAR members. With the member benefit transitioning from a state-level benefit to national, zipForm Standard is no longer included as a free member benefit. As a WRA REALTOR® or section member, in addition to zipForm Plus and zipTMS, you will now gain access to zipForm Mobile and have an unlimited subscription to zipLogix Digital Ink free of charge.

**RENEWAL INSTRUCTIONS—zipForm Plus users:**

Open your account. You will need to accept the license agreement, click Continue, and click Exit Order. You may then sign in to your account again. **\*zipForm Standard users:** You will receive an automatic renewal notification stating that your zipForm 6 account will expire or has expired on March 1. Click Renew Now and follow the prompts to complete the renewal process. Keep in mind \*zipForm 6 Standard is no longer a free member benefit but can still be renewed at a reduced rate of \$29.99 rather than the zipLogic normal rate of \$59.95.

**MLS INFORMATION:****Important Reminder about Scheduling Showings in Paragon:**

When you click on the Schedule a Showing icon within Paragon, a box will pop up with your personal information such as phone number and email. This information is not automatically tied to your member record within Paragon. This is by design so you have flexibility to enter the most appropriate return phone number or email for that particular showing request. The email or phone number as entered will stick until you change it. Because of this flexibility, if you transfer to a new office or change your email or phone number and report that to the MLS to have changed in Paragon, the showing pop up screen will not automatically change; you have to change it. Please glance at this box each time you set up a showing to be sure the email and phone number are as you want them to be. **If you need to make a change, just do it in that screen.**

\*You now have the ability to drag and drop photos into the Upload Picture dialog box.

\*The paging controls to move from listing to listing have been updated for better visibility.

\*The calendar on the home page better reflects tasks as scheduled for contacts.

**Keycard Hot Tip:** Your ActiveKEY has a couple of neat features that can brighten your day.

**FLASHLIGHT:** To initiate the Flashlight function, turn on your ActiveKEY and press the flashlight button (between UP and DOWN arrows at top of keypad). The flashlight will stay on as long as the key stays on.

**BLACKLIGHT:** To activate the Backlight, turn on your ActiveKEY and press the Light Bulb button on the bottom right of the keypad. The key will remain backlit as long as the key stays on.

**Please remember to enter your sold property into pending (click save) before entering the sold information into Paragon with the exception of SBP (Sold Before Publishing).**

When entering a listing, please take extra time to select all the applicable options from the feature pick lists. For example, selecting just 2 car but not attached will result in your listing being missed when agents are searching for an attached garage. It is also

important to select features that are not always visible during a showing, such as an electronic pet containment system, in-floor radiant heat, or a radon mitigation system. These may be desirable to a perspective buyer, but if you don't select them, and the showing agent can't see them, the buyer will never know they exist.

Mismapping Can Result in Missed Showings If you have a listing that is not mapped correctly, it may be missed if an agent is searching by map. Please make it part of your routine to always check the map placement when adding a new listing. If the map placement is not correct, you can adjust it under Listing Maintain - Change GeoCode. When the map displays under maintain, click on the orange map placement marker and move it as needed. Switching to a bird's eye view (click the down arrow next to the word Road in the upper left corner) and using the zoom feature helps to pinpoint the exact location. **Before clicking Save, you may want to zoom out a bit as the zoom level will also be saved.**

**RECIPE****CORNED BEEF AND CABBAGE**

## "Recipe of the Month"

### **MOSTACCIOLI**

1 lb. ground beef  
½ c. chopped onion  
2 cloves garlic, minced  
2 T. shortening  
1 (28 oz.) can tomatoes, cut up  
1 (6oz.) can tomato paste  
1tsp. salt  
4 oz. pepperoni, sliced  
½ lb. fresh mushrooms  
2T. salt  
12 oz. mostaccioli  
Parmesan cheese

Brown ground beef in large skillet. Remove meat from skillet and set aside. In same skillet, cook onion and garlic in hot shortening until tender-crisp. Stir in tomatoes, tomato paste and 1 teaspoon salt. Simmer mixture, covered, for 25 minutes. Stir in meat, pepperoni and mushrooms. Continue cooking for 10 minutes. Skim off excess fat. Cook mostaccioli according to package directions Toss with meat sauce and serve with grated Parmesan cheese.

### **PUNCH**

1qt. cranberry juice  
1 (6 oz.) can frozen lemonade concentrate  
4 (10 oz.) bottle lemon-lime soda  
2 pt. lemon or pineapple sherbet

Blend first 3 ingredients in punch bowl. Refrigerate until needed. At serving time, place small scoop of sherbet in cup or glass and fill with cold punch.
