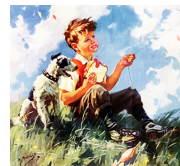

MLS INFORMATION

***THREE IMPORTANT QUESTIONS MOST REALTORS® ARE ASKING REGARDING WITHHELD/DELAYED LISTINGS:

*** (1) MY SELLER IS STILL NOT READY FOR SHOWINGS ON DAY 45...WHAT DO I DO?

A listing can only be in the status of Withheld/Delayed, or as Active with No Showings for 45 days. If a seller is still not ready to show their property on day 46, an extension can be granted. Simply have the seller provide a request for an extension including the reason why. This can be as simple as an email from the seller stating **(I am not ready because the flooring has not been completed.)** Forward this request to the MLS at sue@rockgreenrealtors.org for an extension up to another 45 days. If the MLS does not receive a seller request for an extension, MLS staff will send an email to the listing agent on day 46 as a reminder, and will then move the listing to MLS Suspended.

*** (2) WHY ARE SOME "NO SHOWINGS" UNTIL SHOWING DATE/SPECIFIED DATE ARE IN ACTIVE STATUS INSTEAD OF BEING PLACED IN WITHHELD/DELAYED?

We are generally seeing two reasons a new listing is not available for showings right away. **(1)** The first situation, the property is not ready to be marketed due to clean-up, timing for professional photos, desired staging, etc. You will find these listings in the Withheld/Delayed status as the listing agent does not want them to be viewed by the public yet. **(2)** In the second situation, the property is all ready for public viewing, but the seller and listing agent decide to pick a launch date, often starting with an open house. You will find these listings in Active as the seller and agent want the public to see them. The listings in Active must include the **"date showings will be allowed in the first line of the public remarks"**. Our rules regarding "no showings until" listings have taken both situations into account, and allow agents the flexibility to market these listings as either Withheld/Delayed or Active.

***(3) I LISTED A PROPERTY ON TUESDAY, AND ENTERED IT AS WITHHELD/DELAYED ON FRIDAY, WHY DOES DAYS ON MARKET SHOW AS 3 DAYS?

Within Paragon, you can change the fields that display on the spreadsheet list of properties that come up after a search. Click Customize from the closest toolbar above, and select Fields. The box on the right lists the fields that currently display on your spreadsheet. If you want to remove a field, simply click on the field and click remove. If you want to add a field from the left box, click on the field and then on Add. If you do not see the field you would like to add, click on the Group box at the top to display different types of fields (i.e. Feature Categories). You can also use the Move Up and Move Down buttons to change the order the fields appear on your spreadsheet. Click on Save and Close to apply your changes. Your customized spreadsheet will now come up each time you display the spreadsheet. There is a Revert to Default button on the bottom if you mess up.

*** RatePlug is a valuable tool that lets you share home payment affordability factors directly within any property listing you send your clients, which can get your buyers asking questions about financing earlier, to avoid snags later.

Rock County Housing Statistics

Madison, Wis.—A strong economy and relatively low mortgage rates were not enough to offset the inventory squeeze in Wisconsin housing and as a result, home sales slipped and prices rose statewide.

The statewide economy remains strong as job growth and the state labor force both increased over the past year. Over the past 12 months, the state has added 17,600 manufacturing jobs.

It's not mortgage rates that are keeping sales down, it's the limited number of homes on the market.

Despite the inventory challenges, there are still good opportunities in this market. While it continues to be a seller's market for homes below \$350,000, buyers are in the driver's seat for prices above that point. Regardless of the price point, using a REALTOR® who is experienced is still the key to success in this hot market.

Rock County Housing Statistics—The median price for June 2018 is \$165,000 and for the month of June in 2017 it was \$150,000 that was an increase of +10.0% and the Sales for June 2018 is 243 and June of 2017 was 285 that was an decrease of -14.7%.

Yearly Rock County Housing Statistics—The median price for 2018 is \$153,375 and for 2017 it was \$137,125 that was an increase of +11.9%. The sales for 2018 is 1,092 and in 2017 it was 1,190 that was a decrease of -8.2%.

All county figures on sales volume and median prices are compiled by WRA and are not seasonally adjusted. Median prices are only computed if the county recorded at least 10 home sales in the quarter. Beginning in 2010, all historical sales volume and median price data at the county level have been re-benchmarked using the Techmark system, which accesses MLS data directly and in real time.

"Recipe of the Month"

CUCUMBER CHIP DIP

1 lg. cucumber, finely dices & patted dry
1 (8 oz.) pkg. cream cheese, softened
2 T. milk
1tsp. onion salt
1 sm. onion, finely diced

Press cucumber pieces dry with paper towel. Blend cream cheese with milk until very smooth. Stir in onion salt. Add diced cucumbers and diced onion. Serve with crackers. (Very refreshing!)

COLD CRAB DIP

½ C. crab, shredded
¾ C. sour cream
1 C. sharp Cheddar cheese
¾ c. mayonnaise
2 tsp. horseradish
¼ c. French dressing

Mix. Chill and serve with Ritz crackers.

CRANBERRY MOLDED SALAD

1 (6 oz.) pkg. raspberry gelatin
2 c. boiling water
1 (16 oz.) can whole-berry cranberry sauce
1 sm. can crushed, drained pineapple (save liquid)
½ c. reserved pineapple juice
1/3 c. chopped pecans
½ c. sour cream

Dissolve the gelatin in boiling water. Add remaining ingredients, except for sour cream, and mix well. Add sour cream and fold gently into mixture. Pour into a lightly-oiled 6-7 cup mold or 8-9 inch square baking dish. Cover and chill overnight.
