MLS INFORMATION

Market Monitor Hot Tips:

***You can customize the Market Monitor on the Paragon Home page to limit the display of listings to certain counties, cities, school districts, or types of property. Click the gear to the right of the words Market Monitor to set your preferences.

***Clicking the My Info Tab on the Market Monitor gives you quick access to your current active listings as well as your current offer-no show listings, your current delayed listings, your listings due to expire for days specified, and your solds for the past 6 months. Listings under the Sold within Six Months link include your co-broke sales, allowing easy monitoring to be sure you are given credit for co-broke sales.

***Each MLS participating in WIREX has its own keybox system. When setting up a showing on a listing for which the MLS number starts with alpha characters (i.e. MM), connect with the list agent to make sure you can get into the property.

Most agents in the Metro Milwaukee MLS (MM) use the SentiLock keybox system. Metro agents can issue a one-day code to allow you access.

Most agents in the Northeast (NE) and Central WI (CW) MLSs use the Supra system. If you want to show a NE or CW listing, email keys@wisre.com and request reciprocal Supra access. You need to do this only one time, and there is no additional fee for this reciprocity.

*** Marketing may begin on a property as soon as the listing contract goes into effect (the first date of the term - line 311). This is also the date from which the time frame for MLS entry begins.

Once you begin publicly marketing the property (sign in yard, social media, etc.), the listing needs to be entered on the MLS within 1 business day. (EX.) The property was listed on 7/2, and was entered in the MLS on 7/2, so it was within the required time frame.

***Rule Reminder about Photos Please Photos loaded into Paragon™ should not contain office/agent names, logos, or contact information. Please take photos from an angle to avoid your for sale sign, or from an angle such that your sign is not readable. If this is not possible, please edit your photo to blur or cover the sign before loading it into Paragon™. This rule extends to unbranded virtual tours loaded into Paragon™ as well.

*****When you have an extension please make sure the seller and you sign it the day of or before the contract expires.**

Rock County Housing Statistics

Madison, Wis.—Wisconsin's housing market performed far better than expected in June, with existing home sales down just 4.5% compared to that same month in 2019, and median prices rose 3.6% to \$222,000 over the same 12-month period.

This is better than we expected given the COVID-induced slide in sales we saw last month. The strong pre-coronavirus start to the year helped moderate the total decline in sales in the first half of the year in all regions of the state.

It's good to see June sales come in above our expectations. Improvements to the economy and a consistent decline of mortgage rates into record-low territory has definitely softened the blow from the pandemic. Also, low mortgage rates have kept Wisconsin housing affordable.

There is still a lot of uncertainty, but at least there are some promising signals looking at the second half of 2020 and beyond.

Rock County Housing Statistics—The **median price** for June 2020 is \$185,000 and for the month of June in 2019 it was \$184,000 that was an increase of +0.5% and the **Sales** for June 2020 is 227 and June of 2019 was 253 that was a change of -10.3%. In June of 2020 there was 3.2 months of **inventory** and in June of 2019 there was 3.9 that was a change of -17.9%. Average **days on the market** in June of 2020 was 78 and June of 2019 was 70 that was no change 0.0%.

Statewide Housing Statistics—The median price through June 2020 is \$222,000 and through June of 2019 it was \$214,300 that was an increase of +3.6%. The sales through June of 2020 is 8,401 and June of 2019 was 8,800, a decrease of -4.5%.

All county figures on sales volume and median prices are compiled by WRA and are not seasonally adjusted. Median prices are only computed if the county recorded at least 10 home sales in the quarter. Beginning in 2018, all historical sales volume and median price data from 2015 forward at the county level have been re-benchmarked using the Relitix system that accesses MLS data directly. Data prior to January 2015 is

RECIPE OF THE MONTH

ORANGE-CREAM-FRUIT SALAD

1 (20 oz.) can pineapple tidbits, drained
1 (16 oz.) can peach slices, drained
1 (11 oz.) can mandarin oranges, drained
3 bananas, sliced
2 unpeeled apples, cubed
1 (3 oz.) pkg. instant vanilla pudding
1 ½ c. milk
3 oz. frozen orange juice concentrate, thawed (undiluted)
34 c. sour cream

Combine all of the fruits, except bananas, and set aside, Combine pudding, milk and orange juice; beat until well blended. Stir in sour cream. Fold in fruits. Add bananas last. Refrigerate until ready to serve.

3 oz. cream cheese, softened
½ c. powdered sugar
1 tsp. vanilla
½ pt. whipping cream



Cream cream cheese, powdered sugar and vanilla. Beat in Whipped cream. Spread this mixture over the following crust.

22 graham cracker squares
¼ c. soft butter or margarine

Crush graham cracker squares and mix with the butter. Pat into a 9/13-inch cake pan.

Spread cream cheese mixture on top and top with 1 can cherry pie filling. Refrigerate overnight.

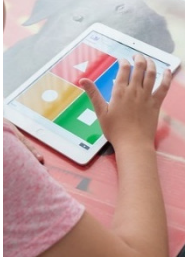
