You will know you have received the update, as your eKEY icon will change. Besides a more user friendly design, the new app will allow access to showing data for boxes you have assigned, and include access to MLS listing data when opening a box. In addition, an option has been added to set a safety alert.

\*\*\*The ability to assign and unassign keyboxes to listings is easily accessible via Paragon. Within Listings - Maintain - Select an Action, there is a link titled Supra Lockbox. Four (4) business days to be entered into MLS.

**Accepted Offers:** (Section 2.5, 2.6 & 2.8, MLS rules of Procedure)

Four (4) business days to be entered into MLS. All Accepted Offers must be reported to MLS. Offers to be reported include contingency (A & B) offers. When the contingencies are fulfilled, properties must be PENDED. Pended offers must be reported prior to the closed transaction in MLS. (1/11/1995)

Sold/Closed: (Section 2.6, MLS rules and Regulations)

Four (4) business days to be entered into MLS. **Note:** To ensure proper credit for a sale in the data system, all sold/closed information shall be entered immediately.

Concessions: Seller Concessions/Discount Points will be reported on Sold/Closed Report or fine will be assessed. (11/21/2002)

### **MLS Officers/Directors**

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#### **Rock County Housing Statistics**

Madison, Wis. —Despite low inventories, WI home sales in 2018 were only slightly off the record sales pace in 2017 as median prices continued to outpace inflation. The month of December closed the year on relatively weak sales volume, with home sales down 13.1% compared to December 2017.

Housing affordability has definitely slipped this year. On one hand, the strong economy has increased family income levels, which tend to improve affordability, but that's countered by strong price appreciation and the upward drift in mortgage rates.

While there's a lot of uncertainty about the future direction of the economy, especially given the volatility in the stock market, we're cautiously optimistic about the housing market in WI in 2019. This should also keep prices from going up as quickly as they did in 2018.

Rock County Housing Statistics—The median price for December 2018 is \$140,450 and for the month of December in 2017 it was \$138,000 that was an increase of +1.8% and the Sales for December 2018 is 142 and December of 2017 was 142 that was a change of 0.0%. In December of 2018 there was 3.1 months of inventory and in December of 2017 there was 2.7 that was an increase of +14.8%. Average days on the market in December of 2018 was 73 and December of 2017 was 84 that was a decrease of -13.1%.

**Statewide Housing Statistics**—The median price through December 2018 is \$179,000 and through December of 2017 it was \$170,000 that was an increase of +5.3%. The sales through December of 2018 is 82,760 and December of 2017 was 84,594 that was a decrease of -2.2%.

All county figures on sales volume and median prices are compiled by WRA and are not seasonally adjusted. Median prices are only computed if the county recorded at least 10 home sales in the quarter. Beginning in 2010, all historical sales volume and median price data at the county level have been rebenchmarked using the Techmark system, which accesses MLS data directly and in real time.

### "Recipe of the Month"

#### RASPBERRY ANGEL FOOD CAKE

Described as 'raspberry floating in a light, white cloud, surrounded by a pool of raspberry sauce'. Fussy but memorable. Fresh raspberries are preferable!

10 egg whites, room temp.

1 ¼ tsp. cream of tartar

¼ tsp. salt

1 tsp. vanilla extract

1 ¼ c. sugar

1 c. flour

1 c. fresh raspberries or well-drained frozen berries

Preheat oven to 325°. In a large bowl, beat egg whites, cream of tartar and salt with electric mixer to form soft peaks. Add vanilla and almond extracts and gradually add the sugar, beating until stiff and shiny. Sift the flour onto the shiny egg whites and sprinkle raspberries with a rubber spatula. Place mixture in a 10-inch ungreased tube pan and bake for 40 minutes. Invert on cake rack and cool completely.

#### **RASPBERRY AMARETTO SAUCE:**

2 C. RASPBERRIES (FRESH OR FROZEN)

½ C. powdered sugar

1 t. lemon juice

3 t. Amaretto liqueur

In a blender or food processor, purée berries. Add rest of ingredients and strain to remove seeds. Serve over cake.
