MLS INFORMATION

***Procuring Cause: Generally procuring cause is the standard of performance relating to the entitlement of cooperative compensation established between brokers via the MLS. While we understand procuring cause to be the standard of performance, understanding what constitutes procuring cause is often times challenging and confusing. In fact, in some instances it is easier to describe what procuring cause is not. It is not a single act. For example, being the first broker or agent to speak to a prospective buyer or to show a home for the first time or even to draft the offer to purchase - does not automatically entitle the broker or agent to "claim" procuring cause. Rather, procuring cause comes down to the concept: who caused the sale of the property. This can only be determined by a full consideration of <u>all</u> of the facts of the transaction. *****Offers of Compensation in WIREX**

Listings appearing in WIREX provide a unilateral offer of compensation to participating WIREX brokers seeking cooperation as subagents and buyer agents. From time-totime, the question is asked: **Does the offer of compensation from the listing broker have to be the same amount to cooperating brokers and their agents who are paid participants and subscribers in an MLS different from that of the listing broker?**

The answer is NO. The listing broker retains the right to determine the amount of compensation offered to subagents and buyer agents – which may be the same or different. The listing broker may offer compensation other than the compensation indicated on the listings published in WIREX provided the listing broker informs the other broker(s) in advance of their submitting an offer to purchase, and the offer of compensation is expressed as either a percentage of the gross sales price or as a flat dollar amount.

For example, a listing broker who is a participant in the Rock-Green MLS may elect to offer a different compensation to participants and their agents who belong to another MLS that is part of WIREX. One way of accomplishing this is to use the private, broker-to-broker remarks: *If the cooperating broker and agent are <u>not</u> members of the Rock-Green MLS, the offer of compensation is __% to subagents and __% to buyer agents.*

*******When searching MLS remarks, you no longer need to include asterisks (* *) around the word or words you are searching for. Did you know MLS Remarks were searchable? Well yes they are! You will find the Remarks search prompt under the "Advanced Criteria" section of the search parameters. Simply type in the word or words you are looking for. If your buyer would like a property that has a large garden space, type large garden and your search results will include properties for which the listing agent has included the words large garden in the remarks. You can also string together multiple words. For example, if your buyer would like a home on a secluded lot, you could type secluded

(tab) private (tab) isolated. Your search will bring back properties for which the listing agent has included any of these words in the remarks. Give it a try the next time you are looking for something there is not a specific search feature for. Also, when composing your remarks, make sure to mention special features not covered elsewhere in the listing features.

If listing is marked as "no showings allowed," whether in withdrawn status or active with a future showing date specified, no REALTOR®, including the listing agent, is allowed to show that listing. Should this status change prior to the original date established by the seller, a written listing amendment, signed by the seller, shall be required and the change reported to Paragon[™] prior to any showings. Lockboxes should not be active during the "no showing" period. (Approved 10/19/2006)

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Rock County Housing Statistics

Madison, Wis.—The combination of strong demand and very weak supply has resulted in a continuing drop in home sales in May. Home sales fell 5% in May 2018 relative to May 2017, and the median price increased 8% to \$188,000 over that same period, which represents the third straight month where home sales have failed to increase from their levels in the previous year.

The WI economy is very strong with robust job growth and record low unemployment rates. A strong economy typically translates into a strong housing market, but you need homes to sell and, unfortunately, they're just not available.

The Federal Reserve is committed to keeping inflation under control and has increased short-term rates by a half percent this year. It has indicated it is likely to add another half percent to those rates by the end of the year.

Rock County Housing Statistics—The median price for May 2018 is \$159,900 and for the month of May in 2017 it was \$148,000 that was an increase of +8.0% and the Sales for May 2018 is 242 and May of 2017 was 238 that was an increase of +1.7%.

Yearly Rock County Housing Statistics—The median price for 2018 is \$150,000 and for 2017 it was \$135,000 that was an increase of +11.1%. The sales for 2018 is 833 and in 2017 it was 849 that was a decrease of -3.8%.

All county figures on sales volume and median prices are compiled by WRA and are not seasonally adjusted. Median prices are only computed if the county recorded at least 10 home sales in the quarter. Beginning in 2010, all historical sales volume and median price data at the county level have been re-benchmarked using the Techmark system, which accesses MLS data directly and in real time.
