I realize that most of us know how to operate the lockbox to get keys out and to put lockboxes on the house. But, it's come to my attention that very few of us realize that we can grant a one day access code to fellow REALTORS®. This is beginning to happen more and more. With the inventory so low we have REALTORS® coming from other areas wanting to show our homes, but their Suprakey will not work or they simply don't have one. Below is two different ways we can grant them access for one day:

To grant non-member access for SupraWeb:

- Login to SupraWeb
- Go to listings section
- Select Keyboxes from quick links
- Click on Key symbol next to box you wish to grant access to
- Enter mobile phone number of person to receive NMA
- Select time range (from 2-72 hours)-can be done days in advance
- Click on submit button

Recipient will be given instructions on how to download the eKey app and authorize it.

To grant Non-member access from the eKey app:

- Open the eKey app
- Tap on Supra WEBN icon
- Login
- Key serial number (at top of eKey home screen)
- Pin
- Organization from drop-down list (WI-South Wisconsin MLS)
- Tap non-member access
- Select a Keybox from the drop down menu
- Tap Grant Access & next
- Enter the non-member mobile phone number
- Submit



I could go on and on about Supra but I think I will have Rock-Green email instruction out so everyone gets them if you have any question you can to scw.mls.com, on left hand side of page click on keys.

From there you can get all kinds of into.

Clear Cooperation Policy

Within one (1) business day of marketing a property to the public, the listing broker must submit the listing to the MLS for cooperation with other MLS participants. Public marketing includes, but is not limited to, flyers displayed in windows, yard signs, digital marketing on public facing websites, brokerage website displays (including IDX and VOW), digital communications marketing (email blasts), multi-brokerage listing sharing networks, and applications available to the general public.

REMINDER—The Rock-Green MLS Adopted this policy to begin on March 1, 2020

MLS INFORMATION

*** MLS Rule Change Regarding Mandatory Inclusion of Listings Effective 3/1/2020

New listings must be entered into the MLS within one (1) business day of being marketed to the public.

***MLS Rule change for Reporting Offers with a Bump:

When reporting an offer with a bump, you have the option to change the status to AB (Offer-Bump), or to leave the status as Active. If you leave the status as Active, you must disclose the offer within the broker-to-broker remarks. (The MLS Board of Directors recently voted to require this disclosure (Offer-Bump) in the **first words** of the broker-to-broker remarks. This new rule applies to offers accepted on or after November 1, 2019.

*****Attention iPhone Users:** iPhone Operating System 13 allows you to select to enable Bluetooth by app. If you are having difficulty using your Supra eKEY, make sure both the overall Bluetooth for your phone is enabled, as well as the Bluetooth for your Supra eKey. To find this setting:

1. Go to the iPhone Settings
2. Tap Privacy
3. Tap Bluetooth
4. Find Supra eKEY, and change the permission

***** New Team Option:** Teams now have an option to be recognized within Paragon. If you currently work within a team, call 1-800-422-8831 for information on setting up your team within Paragon.

*****New Requirement for Recording Team Sales:** Beginning with 2020 sales, if a team participates on the sale side of a transaction, and is registered as a team in the MLS, the listing office must record the sale under the team record. If the team has opted not to register, and does not come up on the list of sale agents within Paragon, you still have the option to record either the team lead or the team member assisting the buyer. Team names are required to include the word Team or Group, so it will be more evident, when reviewing productivity, if an entity is an individual or a team.

*****When adding an associated document to a listing in Paragon,** your document will automatically be set as a private document unless you select the Public check box. Public associated documents are available for the public via e-mailed listing links sent to clients. Private documents are not included when listings are emailed from Paragon, but SCWMLS members have access to them via the Documents link on a listing. We do not send private documents to other MLSs as some other MLSs do not distinguish between public and private, and include all documents with e-mailed listing links to the public. Please make sure to mark your public type documents (i.e. condition reports) as public so agents in other MLSs have access to them.

"Please remember that your list date on the contract must be the list date entered in Paragon™, not the date you enter it. If you are unable to enter the correct date, email sue@rockgreenrealtors.org to get it corrected. Just send me the MLS number and the correct date(s)."

Rock County Housing Statistics

Madison, Wis.—For the second straight month, robust sales of existing homes and limited statewide inventories of homes for sale drove housing prices higher. What is amazing is that we performed so well, in light of historically low inventory levels in January. The WRA began tracking inventory levels in December 2009, and in January we set a new low mark. It’s not surprising to see inventories tighten in the winter, but we’ve never seen them this low, even in January.

The good economy and excellent mortgage rates definitely boosted sales. Unemployment rates have been inching upward but remain below 4%, which is the level that economists consider full employment.

Such strong price growth should be leading to lower affordability, but lower mortgage rates have kept that from happening.

Affordability will likely become a bigger concern as prices naturally increase as we move into the peak sales period in the late spring and summer. Winter and early spring is always a great time to buy as sellers are often more motivated during those times.

Rock County Housing Statistics—The **median price** for January 2020 is \$170,000 and for the month of January in 2019 it was \$149,900 that was an increase of +13.4% and the **Sales** for January 2020 is 111 and January of 2019 was 123 that was a change of -9.8%. In January of 2020 there was 2.7 months of **inventory** and in January of 2019 there was 3.0 that was a change of -10.0%. Average **days on the market** in January of 2020 was 99 and January of 2019 was 103 that was a decrease of -3.9%.

Statewide Housing Statistics—The median price through January 2020 is \$190,000 and through January of 2019 it was \$175,000 that was an increase of +8.6%. The sales through January of 2020 is 4,143 and January of 2019 was 3,804, an increase of +8.9%.

All county figures on sales volume and median prices are compiled by WRA and are not seasonally adjusted. Median prices are only computed if the county recorded at least 10 home

sales in the quarter. Beginning in 2018, all historical sales volume and median price data from 2015 forward at the county level have been re-benchmarked using the Relitix system that accesses MLS data directly. Data prior to January 2015 is derived from the Techmark system that also accessed MLS data directly.

RECIPE OF THE MONTH

Spinach-Stuffed Meat Loaf

- 1 egg
- 2/3 c. ketchup, divided
- ½ c. seasoned dry bread crumbs
- 1 lb. lean ground beef
- 1 (9 oz.) box frozen, chopped spinach, thawed & squeezed dry
- 1 c. shredded Mozzarella cheese

Lightly grease an 8-inch square baking dish. Mix egg and 1/3 cup ketchup in large bowl. Stir in bread crumbs, then mix in meat until blended. Pat half the meat over the bottom of the prepared dish. Sprinkle with a layer of spinach, then cheese. Pat remaining meat mixture on top and spread with remaining 1/3 cup ketchup. Bake at 375° for 30 to 35 minutes. Cut into squares and serve. Yield: 6 servings

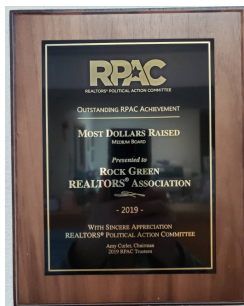
