To put that into perspective, since March 2012, the median price has increased by slightly over 50%.

Withheld/Delayed Listings ready for Showings:

*******When the agent and seller decide it is time to move a property from Withheld/Delayed to Active, it must remain Active for all to show. If at some point later, there is a separate and distinct occurrence (i.e. basement floods, death in the family, etc.) that would necessitate the suspension of showings, the property can then go back into Withheld/Delayed. The seller and agent should be certain they are ready to show when they first move the property out of Withheld/Delayed, as the reason "the seller thought they were ready but changed **their mind**" is not an acceptable separate and distinct occurrence. Please keep in mind that when you move a listing to Active, it is sent to over "500" public websites.

Paragon Tax to be "Replaced" with CRS Data

*******Black Knight, the vendor for Paragon, has partnered with CRS Data, Inc to offer a more robust tax data offering within Paragon. The CRS Tax Search has been turned on in conjunction with Paragon Tax. To try this new program, click on Tax from the top Paragon menu bar. At the bottom of the list of counties click on CRS Data: Tax Search. All counties have been updated with 2018 assessments and taxes. You will also now see two red T action icons. The second will bring you to the new CRS Tax Report. A tentative sunset date for Paragon Tax has been set for May 1.

*******When entering a new listing, you are asked to provide the source for fields such as acres, square footage, and year built. If you select the option of "Other", you are required to indicate what "Other" is in either the public or broker-to-broker remarks.

Rock County Housing Statistics

Madison, Wis. —Existing home sales fell sharply in March and declining inventories put more pressure on home prices.

The economy is in good shape, and that puts a lot of pressure on a housing market with limited supply. In fact, the Wisconsin unemployment rate has ranged between 2.9 % and 3.1% over the last 12 months, and the most recent estimate for February is at the low end of that range.

With this level of price pressure, we would expect to see a significant erosion in housing affordability, but he noted there have been mitigating factors.

Although housing is less affordable today than in 2012, there are still good deals to be had in today's market, but buyers need to have their financing lined up and they need the guidance of a REALTOR® who is experienced.

Rock County Housing Statistics—The median price for March 2019 is \$161,650 and for the month of March in 2018 it was \$153,000 that was an increase of +5.7% and the **Sales** for March 2019 is 160 and March of 2018 was 167 that was a change of -4.2%. In March of 2019 there was 2.8 months of **inventory** and in March of 2018 there was 3.0 that was a change of -6.7%. Average **days on the market** in March of 2019 was 104 and March of 2018 was 107 that was a decrease of -2.8%.

Statewide Housing Statistics—The median price through March 2019 is \$185,000 and through March of 2018 it was \$174,000 that was an increase of +6.3%. The sales through March of 2019 is 13,195 and March of 2018 was 14,248 that was a decrease of -7.4%.

All county figures on sales volume and median prices are compiled by WRA and are not seasonally adjusted. Median prices are only computed if the county recorded at least 10 home sales in the quarter. Beginning in 2010, all historical sales volume and median price data at the county level have been rebenchmarked using the Techmark system, which accesses MLS data directly and in real time.

1 lg. cucumber, finely diced & patted drv

1 (8 oz.) pkg. cream cheese, softened


- 2 T. milk
