


A Note from your Association Executive:

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MLS INFORMATION:

*** How to find your MLS Agent ID: Within

Paragon, each agent is assigned a User Code and a User ID. If you are asked by a vendor (i.e. website provider) to provide your MLS ID, they could be referring to either of these codes, depending on which field they have incorporated for their product. You can find both of these numbers within the Paragon Agent Roster. Click Membership from the top menu bar, and then Agent Roster. Enter your last name within either the Agent Name or Agent ID field. The results will display both your User Code and your User ID. You can either clarify as to which field they are looking for, or just send them both codes.

***** Entering Sold Comps:** When entering a comp sale (listing sold outside MLS), instead of just entering "sold comp" in the remarks, please include features of the property that are not addressed in our pick lists, especially if there is something unique. Accurate and complete data makes our MLS database more useful for everyone using it. Thank you!

******* Delayed Listing Reminder

If you are marketing your Delayed listing to the public (for example, as coming soon or by placing a sign in the yard), you must input that listing in the MLS within 1 business day of when marketing begins. If you are not yet marketing to the public, you have 4 calendar days from the list date to input the listing in the MLS. If you miss the input deadline, there is a \$100 per day fine if you are not advertising, and a \$500 per day fine if you are advertising.

If a listing is not ready to be shown, it cannot be shown by anyone, not even the listing agent/office. Hefty fines have been imposed on listing agents and showing agents for showing a property in Delayed.

***Is your Supra eKEY Ready for the Day?

Before leaving for a showing, especially for a property in an area with spotty cell phone coverage, double check that your Supra eKEY has updated for the day. To check this, look for the Update icon on the bottom of the main eKEY screen. If there is a red X over the Update icon, click to do a manual update. If there is no red X, you are good to go. Once your eKEY is updated for the day, it does not need access to cell service or the internet to retrieve a key or open a keybox shackle.



*** Photo Reminder: Photos loaded into Paragon should not contain office/agent names, logos, or contact information. Please take photos from an angle to avoid your for sale sign, or from an angle such that your sign is not readable. If this is not possible, please edit your photo to blur or cover the sign before loading it into Paragon. This rule extends to unbranded virtual tours loaded into Paragon as well.

Rock County Housing Statistics

Madison, Wis.—Low inventories drove up prices and limited sales in March compared to that same month last year. Existing home sales fell 7% over the past 12 months, and the median price rose 10.2% to \$253,500 over that same period.

Inflationary pressures continue to grow, fueled by supply chain problems, tight labor markets, rising energy prices and the ongoing impact of high levels of stimulus spending. The annual inflation rate increased to 8.5% in March, which is the sixth straight month in which the annual inflation rate has exceeded 6%.

Rapidly rising prices and a significant uptick in mortgage rates has led to a 19.5% reduction in housing affordability in the state. The Wisconsin Housing Affordability Index shows the fraction of the median-priced home that a buyer with median family income qualifies to purchase assuming a 20% down payment and the remaining balance financed with a 30-year fixed-rate mortgage at current rates.

Homes continue to move quickly, with the average days on the market falling from 89 days in March 2021 to 79 days in March 2022.

Brad Lois, 2022 Chair of the WRA Board of Directors, **INVENTORIES AND SALES PERFORMANCE:** "Although REALTORS® have been able to overcome tightening inventories by moving homes more quickly during the slower winter months, that will be increasingly difficult as we transition into the prime buying season. We expect home sales to lag behind the record pace of 2021."

Michael Theo, WRA President and CEO tells us, **LOWER AFFORDABILITY SHOULD SOFTEN DEMAND PRESSURE:** "Weak supply and strong demand have pushed prices up by around 10% on an annual basis, and with mortgage rates now going up more quickly, housing affordability is starting to suffer. Mortgage rates in early April are moving closer to 5% and this trend will likely moderate housing demand pressure over the next few months as some potential buyers drop out of the market."

Dave Clark, Marquette University Economist and WRA Consultant, **INFLATION PROBLEM FUELS INCREASE IN MORTGAGE RATES:** "The Federal Reserve has a dual mandate to maintain full employment and also maintain price stability, defined as a 2% annual inflation rate target. Given the acceleration of the inflation rate over the past year, the Fed is focusing its attention on controlling inflation by aggressively raising the shortterm federal funds rate. While its actions are spiking mortgage rates in the short term, controlling inflationary expectations is key to returning 30-year fixed mortgage rated to the more3 favorable 3% to 4% range we've seen over the past decade."

Rock County Housing Statistics—The median price for March 2022 is \$190,250 and for the month of March in 2021 it was \$189,000 that was an increase of +0.7% and the **Sales** for March 2022 is 156 and March of 2021 was 161 that was a decrease of -3.1%. In March of 2022 there was 2.2 months of **inventory** and in March of 2021 there was 2.2 that was 0.0% change. Average **days on the market** in March of 2022 was 85 and March of 2021 was 70 that was an increase of +21.4%.

Statewide Housing Statistics—The median price through March 2022 is \$240,000 and through March of 2021 it was \$219,000 that was an increase of +9.6%. The sales through March of 2022 is 14,689 and through March of 2021 was 15,358 that was a -4.4% change.

All county figures on sales volume and median prices are compiled by WRA and are not seasonally adjusted. Median prices are only computed if the county recorded at least 10 home sales in the quarter. Beginning in 2018, all historical sales volume and median price data from 2015 forward at the county level have been re-benchmarked using the Relitix system that accesses MLS data directly. Data prior to January 2015 is derived from the Techmark system that also accessed MLS data directly.

2023 Annual Dues Pre-Payment Plan

2023 you say? Yes, this is a program we started a few years ago and it has helped members get a head start on your dues so that you don't get caught paying the whole total in November when the holiday season starts. It is your choice, you can pay monthly, quarterly or just pay half then pay the other half when due or any amount at any time for a one-time \$5 counter fee. If you pay the total amount at any time there will not be a fee. Examples are: Monthly (Feb. 2022 thru September 2022) is \$88.50 a month with the last payment adjusted when we find out what the dues totals are. Quarterly (March, May, July and September) are \$177 with the last payment adjusted if needed. Estimated total \$708.00.
