EDUCATION | REALTOR® CE DEADLINE APPROACHING

No, well then you have until December 14, 2020 to get your CE done. That is the 2019-2020 Biennium Deadline. In order to maintain your Wisconsin real estate license, you must complete your 2019-2020 CE Credits by Dec. 14.

Annual Association Dues Deadline? November 20th is the Deadline for On-Time Payments. After the 20th a late fee could be assessed. You can mail them or you can drop them off at the office. November 12, New Member Orientation **November 20**, On-Time Dues Deadline

MLS INFORMATION

***Important Rule Change: On October 1st, the show date will again be required, and the maximum number of days a listing can be in Delayed, or Active with no showings will again be 45 days. As you know, show date was changed to optional, and the 45-day limit was removed at the onset of COVID-19. As there has been adequate time to employ best practices in safe selling, we feel reverting to the requirement of the show date, and the 45-day maximum is now warranted. All listings entered or modified on or after October 1 will trigger the requirement for show date.

***Friendly *Rule Reminder:* If you have blocked out dates or times for showings via the ShowingTime calendar, no showings are allowed during those times.....not even for the listing agent.

***Before leaving for a showing, especially for a property in an area with spotty cell phone coverage, double check that your Supra eKEY has updated for the day. To check this, look for the Update icon on the bottom of the main eKEY screen. If there is a red X over the Update icon, click to do a manual update. If there is no red X, you are good to go

***Quickly load a previous search you did in Paragon by selecting the Last Search option located above Primary Criteria after selecting Class. Hovering over Last Search will display the 5 previous searches you performed. Clicking on one of these searches will load the search criteria for that past search.

***When you have an extension please make sure the seller and you sign it the day of or before the contract expires.

***New Mobile Access Upgrade your mobile access to Paragon Connect. Currently, your options for mobile access to Paragon include Paragon Mobile and Homesnap. Paragon Mobile will soon be replaced with the next generation of mobile access. Paragon Connect is a web application that utilizes the same database as Paragon Online, which allows real-time access to your listings, contacts, saved searches and customized search defaults. Within Paragon Connect you have full search capability with links to not only full property data, but also history, associated documents, public records, and access to schedule a showing via ShowingTime. Paragon Connect has a very tight integration with Link on the homepage of Paragon, Collaboration Center for those who have

Rock County Housing Statistics

Madison, Wis. —When we consider what transpired last spring, we never would have imagined how quickly the housing market would rebound. The economic lockdown of the state pushed annualized sales down 23% in May alone. But, as mortgage rates fell to their lowest level on record, the Wisconsin existing home market responded with record September sales and robust price appreciation.

Demand has increased in recent months for a couple of reasons: low mortgage rates and an improving job market in the state. Mortgage rates began dropping in January, and the aggressive actions by the Federal Reserve Bank to mitigate the effects of the economic shutdown have pushed mortgage rates to record-low levels for six straight months.

The Consumer Confidence Index published by the Conference Board showed a sharp increase in September, in terms of consumers' assessment of both current and short-term future conditions. This likely bodes well for the housing market over the next few months.

Rock County Housing Statistics—The median price for September 2020 is \$188,000 and for the month of September in 2019 it was \$164,950 that was an increase of +14.0% and the **Sales** for September 2020 is 213 and September of 2019 was 210 that was an increase of +1.4%. In September of 2020 there was 3.4 months of **inventory** and in September of 2019 there was 3.8 that was a decrease of -10.5%. Average **days on the market** in September of 2020 was 68 and September of 2019 was 85 that was a decrease of -20.0%.

Statewide Housing Statistics—The median price through September 2020 is \$219,900 and through September of 2019 it was \$198,500 that was an increase of +10.3%. The sales through September of 2020 is 63,790 and September of 2019 was 62,721 that was an increase of +1.7%.

All county figures on sales volume and median prices are compiled by WRA and are not seasonally adjusted. Median prices are only computed if the county recorded at least 10 home sales in the quarter. Beginning in 2018, all historical sales volume and median price data from 2015 forward at the county level have been re-benchmarked using the Relitix system that accesses MLS data directly. Data prior to January 2015 is derived from the Techmark system that also accessed MLS data directly.

RECIPE OF THE MONTH

TURKEY CASSEROLE

2 c. cubed, cooked turkey

1 c. chopped celery

½ c. toasted silvered almonds

½ tsp, salt

2 T. lemon juice

2 tsp. grated onion

2/3 c. mayonnaise

1 c. crushed potato chips

½ c. grated American cheese

Combine all ingredients, except potato chips and cheese; toss lightly. Turn into a greased 7x11-inch baking dish. Sprinkle with potato chips and cheese, and bake at 450° for 10 minutes. Yield 4 servings.

TURKEY DIVAN

1 (30 oz.) can cling peach slices

2 (10 oz.) pkg. frozen broccoli, or 1 bunch fresh

2 lb. sliced turkey (skin removed)

2 c. Rich White Sauce

½ c. grated Parmesan cheese

Drain peaches will. Cook broccoli until tender; drain thoroughly. While broccoli is cooking, prepare Rich White Sauce. Layer in 2-quart casserole, broccoli, turkey, peaches twice and top with sauce.

Rich White Sauce:

¼ c. butter

¼ c. flour

Dash of Cayenne pepper

¼ tsp. dry mustard

¼ tsp. salt

1 c. milk

1 c. light cream (half & half)

Melt butter in skillet. Stir in flour, cayenne pepper, mustard and salt; stir until smooth. Gradually stir in milk and cream. Cook until thickened and smooth, stirring constantly.

Yield: 4 servings

Note: This can be prepared ahead and heated will in the oven before serving. Be sure to drain the peaches and broccoli well to the sauce doesn't get watered down. Excellent way to use up that holiday turkey!
