***ShowingTime Hot Tip: Never miss а ShowingTime alert again - install the free ShowingTime Mobile App. Email notifications about showings can sometimes get blocked, delayed, or sent to your spam folder. The ShowingTime app uses push notifications that cannot be blocked. You also have access to showing instructions, feedback, buyer tours, and more while out in the field. Go to Paragon™ for installation instructions. ***Attention Yahoo/AOL/Verizon users --- if you host your email via Yahoo, AOL or Verizon, please note that these providers have blocked ShowingTime emails several times in the past.

***Email auto-notifications of price changes are sent from Paragon only if the price change is at least .5%. This setting limits the practice of \$1 price changes to gain exposure. Within the price column on spreadsheets, a price in red indicates a price decrease, and a price in green indicates a price increase. In addition, if you hover over the arrow, the previous price and percentage of change will display. Price changes are highlighted for 2 weeks.

***Supra Update required for iPhone/iPad

Users: Apple released a new operating system, iOS 13, for iPhones and iPads, on September 19. A new version of the Supra eKEY app is now available in the Apple app store. Please update your eKEY app to this new version **before** you update your iPhone or iPad to iOS 13. You may not be able to access keyboxes if you use a previous version of the eKEY app with iOS 13.

Rock County Housing Statistics

Madison, Wis. —Wisconsin home sales fell by a modest margin even as median prices moved up sharply in August. Existing home sales fell 2.1% in August 2019 compared to August 2018, while median prices rose 9.0% over that same period to \$206,000. On a year-to-date basis, the picture is similar. Although we have seen volatile monthly sales over the past years, the summer sales performance has been very stable since 2015.

With tight supply and strong demand, robust price appreciation is to be expected, and that's exactly what we're seeing. We have been lucky that mortgage rates have been falling all year, which has kept our housing relatively affordable.

With the Fed clearly in a rate-cutting mode, we expect more downward pressure on mortgage rates, which should result in modest improvements in affordability over the next few months.

Rock County Housing Statistics—The **median price** for August 2019 is \$170,500 and for the month of August in 2018 it was \$169,900 that was an increase of +0.4% and the **Sales** for August 2019 is 258 and August of 2018 was 233 that was a change of +10.7%. In August of 2019 there was 3.5 months of **inventory** and in August of 2018 there was 4.1 that was a change of -14.6%. Average **days on the market** in August of 2019 was 72 and August of 2018 was 73 that was a decrease of -1.4%.

Statewide Housing Statistics—The median price through August 2019 is \$199,000 and through August of 2018 it was \$185,000 that was an increase of +7.6%. The sales through August of 2019 is 54,199 and August of 2018 was 56,010, a decrease of -3.2%.

All county figures on sales volume and median prices are compiled by WRA and are not seasonally adjusted. Median prices are only computed if the county recorded at least 10 home sales in the quarter. Beginning in 2018, all historical sales volume and median price data from 2015 forward at the county level have been re-benchmarked using the Relitix system that accesses MLS data directly. Data prior to January 2015 is derived from the Techmark system that also accessed MLS data directly.

Hot Apple Cider

1 gal. apple cider

6 oz. frozen lemonade

6 oz. orange juice

6 whole cloves

4 cinnamon sticks

Heat all together and serve!

1 (8 oz.) ctn. sour cream

¼ c. dry bread crumbs (plain)

1 T. sugar

1 T. butter, melted

Preheat oven to 375°. Place blueberries in crust; set aside. Combine brown sugar, flour, vanilla, rind and sour cream; spread over blueberries. Combine bread crumbs, sugar and butter; sprinkle over sour cream mixture. Bake for 40 minutes, or until set and crumbs are lightly browned. Cool 1 hour on wire rack. Yield: 8 happy people servings.
