MLS INFORMATION

*** Load Multiple Listing Photos Quickly: Within the Picture Administration window, there is an option to Upload Multiple Photos in the upper left corner. To upload photos click the Browse button and select all photos and then click Upload. Once the photos are loaded, rearrange as needed and Save.

When arranging photos, if you end up with a blank box between photos, you can simply drag that blank photo graphic to the end instead of moving each photo ahead by one space. If you leave a blank box, Paragon is smart enough to ignore it in the slideshow, but reports with multiple photos and some data exports are not as smart. Bottom line -- don't leave blank spots between photos.

*** Two Options to Keep you Safe: Within both the ShowingTime and the Supra eKEY apps, there is a free feature that allows you to create an email alert to selected contacts. The ShowingTime alert works on a timer or allows an immediate panic button push. Supra allows for an immediate panic button push.

Paragon has links to guide you with the setup of security.

***Each MLS participating in WIREX has its own keybox system. When setting up a showing on a listing for which the MLS number starts with alpha characters (i.e. MM), connect with the list agent to make sure you can get into the property. Most agents in the Metro Milwaukee MLS (MM) use the SentriLock keybox system. Metro agents can issue a one-day code to allow you access. Most agents in the Northeast (NE) and Central WI (CW) MLSs use the Supra system. If you want to show a NE or CW listing, email keys@wisre.com and request reciprocal Supra access. Indicate which system you would like reciprocal access for based on the alpha prefix. You need to do this only one time per MLS system, and there is no additional fee for this reciprocity.

***Zillow Listing Edit Removed: Now that Zillow is a brokerage, they no longer give agents the ability to edit listings sent to Zillow via MLS IDX data feeds. If you still have access to edit your listing, it is because your listing is also on Zillow from a secondary source, such as a franchise. When looking at your listing on Zillow, you will find the data source or sources under the Listed By information. The example below shows this listing provided via the WIREX MLS data feed and the RE/MAX International data feed. Information from the WIREX MLS data feed will be the primary display, but the consumer can click on the secondary source to see a slightly different view of the listing. If you still have the option to edit your listing, you are actually editing the secondary source display, not the primary MLS source display. This has caused some confusion for our members, as they expect to see their edits on the primary MLS source display.

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
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Rock County Housing Statistics

Madison, Wis. —For the second straight month, sales fell in every region of the state, and they dropped the most in the North and central regions, down 19.1% and 3.7% respectively. The Northeast region saw its August sales fall 9.8% compared to 12 months earlier, whereas the South Central, Southeast and West regions all fell by much smaller margins: the South Central region was down 2.2%, the Southeast region was down 2%, and the West region was down 2.9%.

Overall, this has been a solid summer for home sales, with closings for June, July and August just 5.6% below the record summer home sales recorded in 2020. Year to date, statewide sales are ahead of the pace recorded in 2020, with 6,503 sales in the first eight months of 2021, up 2.7% over the January-August period in 2020. The median price is up 10.6% to \$240,000 over that same period.

Mary Duff, 2021 Chair of the WRA Board of Directors, "Given the supply problem, it's not surprising that sales this summer have not quite kept up with the record pace established last summer. Even though REALTORS® have been moving homes quickly, they can only sell what's on the market, so we'll continue to struggle to increase our sales on a year-over-year basis until the inventory situation improves."

Michael Theo, WRA President and CEO tells us, "Strong demand and weak supply create ideal conditions for strong price appreciation, and that's exactly what we've been seeing over the past year. However, there are some preliminary signs that the double-digit price home price increases may be moderating slightly. The annual rate of appreciation was over 14% in May and June, it fell to just over 10% in July and to 6.4% in August. That is welcome news since unstainable price increases can reduce demand, keeping creditworthy buyers out of purchasing homes."

Rock County Housing Statistics—The median price for August 2021 is \$205,000 and for the month of August in 2020 it was \$190,000 that was an increase of +7.9% and the **Sales** for August 2021 is 282 and August of 2020 was 236 that was an increase of +19.5%. In August of 2021 there was 3.1 months of **inventory** and in August of 2020 there was 3.4 that was a decrease of -8.8%. Average **days on the**

market in August of 2021 was 58 and August of 2020 was 79 that was a decrease of -26.6%.

Statewide Housing Statistics—The median price through August 2021 is \$240,000 and through August of 2020 it was \$217,000 that was an increase of +10.6%. The sales through August of 2021 is 56,503 and through August of 2020 was 55,029 that was +2.7% change.

All county figures on sales volume and median prices are compiled by WRA and are not seasonally adjusted. Median prices are only computed if the county recorded at least 10 home sales in the quarter. Beginning in 2018, all historical sales volume and median price data from 2015 forward at the county level have been re-benchmarked using the Relitix system that accesses MLS data directly. Data prior to January 2015 is derived from the Techmark system that also accessed MLS data directly.

RECIPE OF THE MONTH PUMPKIN BARS



4 eggs

2 c. sugar

1 (16 oz.) can pumpkin

34 c. melted butter

2 c. flour

2 tsp. baking powder

1 tsp. baking soda

½ tsp. cinnamon

1 c. chopped walnuts (opt)

Combine eggs, sugar, pumpkin and butter. Add remaining ingredients and mix. Pour into a greased and floured jellyroll pan, or if using only half the recipe, into a 9×13 -inch pan. Bake 20 to 25 minutes at 325° . Frost with icing.

ICING:

3 oz. cream cheese, softened

6 T. butter, softened

1 tsp. vanilla

1 T. milk

3 c. powdered sugar

Beat cream cheese and butter until smooth. Add vanilla, milk and powdered sugar; beat well. Spread on cooled bars

VARIATION: Can also put chopped nuts on top, if desired. Oh, this is a good one!


