MLS INFORMATION

***If you have a buyer requesting to be in a specific school district, do not simply search by the municipality or mailing city you think is serviced by that school district, but rather use the School District search field. There are many instances where school districts span several municipalities and mailing cities, and it is easy to miss listings if you are not aware of all of them. For example, the school district of DeForest spans six different municipalities and seven different mailing cities. If you limit your search to the Village of DeForest, you would miss over 50% of properties serviced by the DeForest School District.

***Cool Tool: If your company uses ShowingTime Appointment Center, you can run target market analysis by location for the number of showings within price ranges. Click on link in Paragon $^{\text{TM}}$ Home page. This report can be found toward the bottom of the Reports menu within ShowingTime Appointment Center.

***Video Links: Collaboration Center, CRS Tax, Homesnap and RPR can be found on the homepage of Paragon™.

***Each MLS participating in WIREX has its own keybox system. When setting up a showing on a listing for which the MLS number starts with alpha characters (i.e. MM), connect with the list agent to make sure you can get into the property. Most agents in the Metro Milwaukee MLS (MM) use the SentriLock keybox system. Metro agents can issue a one-day code to allow you access. Most agents in the Northeast (NE) and Central WI (CW) MLSs use the Supra system. If you want to show a NE or CW listing, email keys@wisre.com and request reciprocal Supra access. You need to do this only one time, and there is no additional fee for this reciprocity.

***Rule Reminder about Photos Please Photos loaded into Paragon™ should not contain office/agent names, logos, or contact information. Please take photos from an angle to avoid your for sale sign, or from an angle such that your sign is not readable. If this is not possible, please edit your photo to blur or cover the sign before loading it into Paragon™. This rule extends to unbranded virtual tours loaded into Paragon™ as well.

***Quickly load a previous search you did in Paragon by selecting the Last Search option located above Primary Criteria after selecting Class. Hovering over Last Search will display the 5 previous searches you performed. Clicking on one of these searches will load the search criteria for that past search.

***When you have an extension please make sure the seller and you sign it the day of or before the contract expires.

Rock County Housing Statistics

Madison, Wis. —Wisconsin's existing home sales hit a new record for the month of July, which increased prices by double digits.

There were just four months of available supply in July, which is well below the six-month level that indicates a balanced market. We've been in a seller's market for almost three years.

We just had the biggest quarterly contraction in U.S. history. While this is a shocking figure, it's not surprising given the economic lockdown intended to control the pandemic. There will be mixed economic signals in the months ahead, but improvement is expected in the second half of the year.

We can't expect record sales every month especially given the supply crunch, but these record-low mortgage rates will fuel the demand side for the late summer and fall sales season. This is a great time for sellers to list their homes.

Rock County Housing Statistics—The median price for July 2020 is \$211,000 and for the month of July in 2019 it was \$183,000 that was an increase of +15.3% and the **Sales** for July 2020 is 261 and July of 2019 was 255 that was a change of +2.4%. In July of 2020 there was 3.0 months of **inventory** and in July of 2019 there was 3.9 that was a change of -23.1%. Average **days on the market** in July of 2020 was 83 and July of 2019 was 72 that was an increase of +15.3%.

Statewide Housing Statistics—The median price through July 2020 is \$226,400 and through July of 2019 it was \$205,000 that was an increase of +10.4%. The sales through July of 2020 is 9,649 and July of 2019 was 8,969, an increase of +7.6%.

All county figures on sales volume and median prices are compiled by WRA and are not seasonally adjusted. Median prices are only computed if the county recorded at least 10 home sales in the quarter. Beginning in 2018, all historical sales volume and median price data from 2015 forward at the county level have been re-benchmarked using the Relitix system that accesses MLS data directly. Data prior to January 2015 is derived from the Techmark system that also accessed MLS data directly.

RECIPE OF THE MONTH

AUTUMN TOSSED SALAD

½ c. lemon juice

½ c. sugar

2 tsp. chopped onion

½ tsp. salt

1 tsp. Dijon mustard

2/3 c. vegetable oil

1 T. poppy seeds

1 bunch romaine lettuce, torn

1 c. shredded Swiss cheese

1 c. cashews

1 apple, unpared and chopped

1 pear, chopped

¼ c. dried cranberries

Combine first 5 ingredients and gradually add oil in a steady stream. Stir in poppy seeds. Cover and refrigerate 1 hour. In large salad bowl, combine remaining ingredients. Drizzle with dressing and toss gently to coat. Serve and enjoy!

FROSTED FRUIT SALAD

1 (3 oz.) pkg. lemon Jello

1 (3 oz.) orange Jello

2 c. boiling water

1 $\frac{1}{2}$ c. cold water

¼ c. lemon juice

1 sm. can crushed pineapple

2 banans

1 c. mini marshmallows

Dissolve both packages of Jello in the 2 cups of boiling water. Mix in cold water and lemon juice. Add 1 cup crushed pineapple, drained (reserve liquid), dices bananas and miniature marshmallows. Place in a 9x13-inch pan and refrigerate. Do not frost until set.

FROSTING:

1 sm. ctn. Cool Whip (or 1 c. whipped cream)

2 T. flour

½ c. sugar

2 T. butter

1 egg

Pineapple juice (reserved from above)

1 c. walnuts

Mix flour, sugar slightly-beaten egg and pineapple juice. Cook until thickened, then add butter and cool. Fold in 1 small container Cool Whip; spread over Jello and sprinkle top with nuts. Chill and serve!
