

MLS INFORMATION:

Q: I have a listing contract with a seller who has decided they do not want to sell their home now. What do I do with the listing in the MLS?

A: If your broker has released the seller from the contract, the status will be changed in the MLS to Expired. Use the date of the termination as the expiration date. If your broker has not released the seller from his/her contract, change the status of the listing to **Withheld by Seller** in the MLS and add "**Off Market per Sellers Request"** within the first line of the public remarks to indicate the listing will not be available for showings for the rest of the listing term.

Something New! A new link to validate map placement has been added after the Zip Code within the add/maintain listing process. This is an optional link that Paragon will show you where your place is on the listing map. From this window you can adjust the map location with an easy click and drag. You can also adjust the zoom level with the plus and minus sign. The zoom level will display on reports within Paragon.

MLS Requests:

Please remember to send all MLS Requests to the Association office within 48 hours of date sent. Please remember that if we do not receive the request within the 48 hour time allotted fines will be enforced. Call the Association office if you are out of town or ill, your request will be waived. The fines are still the same as before, \$2 a day for the first 5 days, \$10 a day up to \$110. The requests are randomly picked.

The **MLS COMMITTEE** makes decisions about changes to Paragon, the keycard system, and MLS rules. Please remember when taking photos of your listings you should take the photos before placing your sign. If that is not possible blur out the sign with your name and office. Your information is not allowed in the photo.

ActiveKey Displays **"Call to Enable"**There are 3 possible causes for the "Call to Enable" message

- 1) The ActiveKey battery is too low (The ActiveKey should be plugged into its power adapter at least every other night for charging)
- 2) The ActiveKey was out of cellular range for 24 hours or more
- 3) There could be a billing problem or a problem with status.

ARE YOU BORROWING OR USING AN ACTIVE KEY THAT IS NOT YOURS? If you are, this can be costly for each of you and the Broker! KEY HOLDER BEWARE!!!!!

If each are key holders, 1^{st} offense Reprimand for all, 2^{nd} offense \$25 fine for each agent and broker and 3^{rd} offense also \$25 fine for each.

If user is a Non-key holder, 1^{st} offense \$100 fine for each agent and broker, 2^{nd} offense \$500 for each agent and broker, 3^{rd} offense \$1000 fine for each agent and broker.

Mandatory Association Core Standards

In early 2014, National Association President, Steven Brown convened a Presidential Advisory Group of association executives to determine what the core standards should be. And by setting a set of core standards for every local and state association they are taking a giant step forward in ensuring that we reach or goals together. Steven says, "Only as a united association with common goals and a common vision are we stronger." So then the standards were developed by the Organizational Standards PAG and with feedback from AE's across the country they were approved in May by the NAR Board of Directors.

From time to time you will hear me reference the new Core Standards Policy. When you see this try and do your part to achieve this goal. There are six components—Code of Ethics, advocacy, consumer outreach, unification, technology and financial solvency.

"The goal of the standards is to ensure that every member is provided with the services they deserve and that every association is contributing to the strength of the organization as a whole," Brown says.

NOTICE!! Your 2015 Annual Membership Dues will be due soon! This notice is for every member, with a special reminder for our new members that have just joined or joined within the last few years. When you

applied you paid your Fees for that year. You were informed that your Annual Dues statements will be sent out in August/September for the following years dues. That date is coming fast-----. They are due upon receipt but you do have until December to pay them. To avoid the end of the year crunch, you might want to use our Pre-Pay Plan. You can pay ½ now or any amount to help avoid the holiday crunch. We do not have the exact amount due at this time, we are going by last year's totals. So half would be \$300 for Realtors or \$200 for Affiliates. Or, any amount you would like to pay. Just a one-time \$5 fee would be charged. This option ends on August 31, 2014.

Recipe of the Month

Country Bread

Ingredients:

2 packages dry yeast 2 cups warm water ½ cup sugar 1 tablespoon salt

2 large eggs

14 cup of oil

6-6 ½ cups of flour

Directions:

Dissolve yeast in warm water. Stir in the sugar, salt, eggs, and oil with 3 cups of flour. Beat until smooth. Mix in enough remaining flour to make dough easy to handle. Turn the dough onto a floured board and knead until smooth and elastic. (10 minutes) Place in greased bowl. (can be refrigerated 3-4 days)

Cover and let rise in warm place until double in size usually 1 hour. Dough is ready if impression remains when a finger is pressed into the dough.

Punch down the dough. Divide into 2 sections. Shape into loaves, place in greased bread pans, brush with oil, then let rise until it doubles in size. (1 hour) Heat oven to 375°, place on lower rack so top of pans are in the center of the oven. Use foil to keep the tops from browning too much. Bake 30-30 minutes. Remove from the pan and brush with butter.

Apple Crisp

Ingredients:

1 cup sugar

1/4 cup water

½ tsp cinnamon

6 apples (sliced)

34 cup flour

¼ tsp salt

6 T butter

Directions:

Combine ½ cup sugar with water and cinnamon in an 8X8X2 inch pan. Peel the apples and slice then add to mixture. Mix the other ½ cup of sugar with the flour salt and butter to resemble pie crust. Sprinkle on top to the apple mixture. Bake for 40-45 minutes at 375°.
